### Hangar Facts:

- \$8.75 million dollar project completed in under 12 months.
- 260' x 305' hangar with a 58' high door is large enough to house any aircraft in the world, except the Airbus A380.

- The hangar is 79,300 sq feet – 1.82 acres under a single clear span roof.
- Interior volume – approx. 6 million cubic feet.
- 17,664,000 lbs. of concrete, with 4,020,000 lbs. poured in a single day.
- 2,052,000 lbs. of steel.
